

## MINUTES of the Executive Committee Quarterly Meeting Friday, September 6, 2024 Newcastle Lodge, Newcastle, WY

The quarterly meeting of the Wyoming Historical Society was called to order at 9:02 am by President Cindy Brown. The meeting took place at the Newcastle Lodge in Newcastle, Weston County, WY.

Those in attendance of the Executive Committee were Cindy Brown, President; Cheryl O'Brien, Fist Vice President; Jessica Flock, Second Vice President; Heidi McCullough, Treasurer; and Lucas Keeler. WHS Executive Director Aley Philp was in attendance along with guests Donna Kenney, Deb Davidson, Linda Fabian, Lynn Houze, Arlene Robbins, Rick Robbins, Mike Jording, and Tom Rea.

Mike Jording welcomed everyone to Weston County and the preliminaries of the 71st Annual Meeting.

Heidi McCullough moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Jessica Flock. Motion carried.

Cheryl O'Brien moved to approve the minutes from the June 23, 2024 meeting. Seconded by Lucas Keeler; motion carried.

Treasurer Heidi McCullough presented her report. Cheryl O'Brien moved to accept the Treasurer's report. It was seconded by Jessica Flock, motion carried.

Linda Fabian reported on the Wyoming Historical Foundation on behalf of Ann Nobel, WHF President. It was moved, seconded, and approved to recommend Rick Robbins to continue for another three years as a member of the Foundation. He currently serves as Vice-President. The Foundation will be accepting nominations from the floor at the Annual Meeting on September 7, 2024 for two more additional members.

The FY 2025 Budget was recommended for approval at the General Membership Annual Meeting, with changes. The recommendation was moved by Jessica Flock, seconded by Cheryl O'Brien; motion carried.

Aley Philp gave an overview of her Executive Director's report.

A discussion was held regarding the Wyoming Non-Profit Networks "WyoGives Day" every July 10<sup>th</sup>. A motion was made to that a percentage split would need to be established for 2025's WyoGives Day and that the

Wyoming Historical Society would work with the Foundation, and other projects of the Society to promote the event, especially through social media. Jessica Flock moved, seconded by Lucas Keeler; motion carried.
